NSLS TRIP CODE OF CONDUCT

The following Code of Conduct applies to you and all other participants in the Trip. By checking the box below, you acknowledge that you have read this Code of Conduct and agree to abide by all of its terms. This Code of Conduct is meant to ensure that all participants, including you, have an enjoyable experience on the Trip and while participating in any activities. Your failure to comply with this Code of Conduct may result in your immediate dismissal from a Trip or Activity.

1. All True Nature leaders, instructors, or other personnel must be obeyed at all times during a Trip or any Activity.
2. While on a Trip, participants must comply with any code of conduct, standards of behavior, or rules of the educational institution at which the participant is enrolled.
3. Participants will at all times be respectful of other participants and True Nature leaders, instructors, or other personnel.
4. The following conduct will not be tolerated and, in the sole discretion of True Nature, may result in immediate dismissal from a Trip or Activity:
 - a. Conduct, including speech, that physically harms, threatens, or is abusive towards True Nature leaders, instructors, or other personnel or other participants.
 - b. Sexual harassment or misconduct of any kind, including but not limited to unwelcome physical conduct, physical violence, sexually explicit conversations, sexually-suggestive gestures, or sexual exchange.
 - c. Theft or misappropriation of property that is owned by True Nature or another participant.
 - d. The unlawful possession, use, manufacture, distribution, or dispensation of controlled substances or other illegal drugs.
 - e. Excessive intoxication, as determined by True Nature in its sole discretion, due to alcohol.
 - f. Criminal activity of any kind.
 - g. Room assignments must be adhered to throughout the trip. Non-participants are not permitted in rooms under any circumstances.
 - h. Any other conduct which is deemed by True Nature, in its sole discretion, to be disruptive to the Trip or otherwise interferes with other participants' experience on the Trip.

If a violation of this Code of Conduct occurs, a variety of steps may be taken by True Nature, up to and including a participant's immediate dismissal from a Trip or Activity. True Nature reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine what it believes is an appropriate response to misconduct and to implement it.

True Nature will report any violation of this Code of Conduct to the participant's educational institution and The National Society for Leadership and Success.

If a participant is dismissed from a Trip or Activity as a result of a violation of this Code of Conduct, any amounts paid to True Nature, including the Initial Deposit, Tuition, and processing fee, are non-refundable and non-transferable. True Nature reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to dismiss a participant from a Trip or Activity due to a violation of this Code of Conduct.
